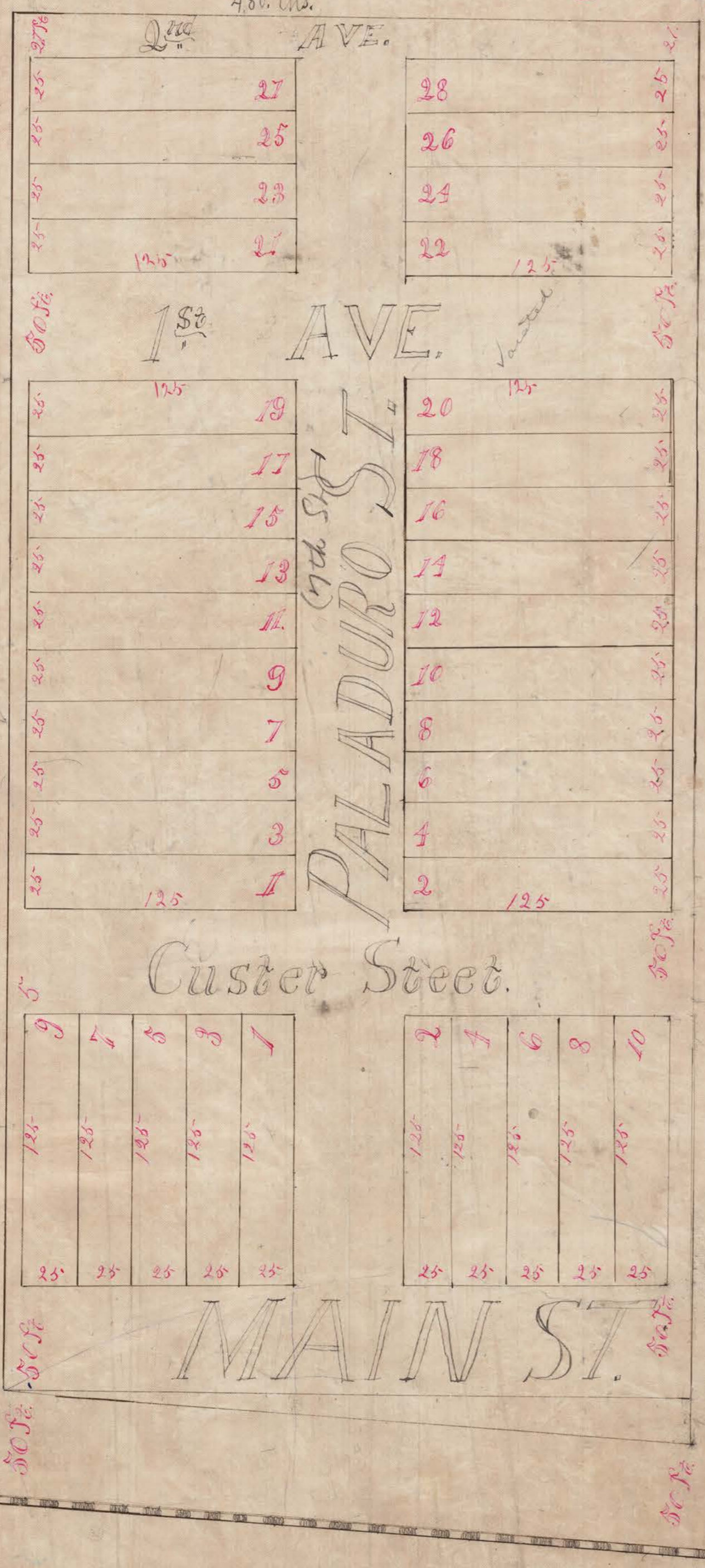

Jacob Collar.

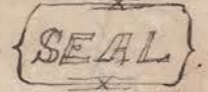

This Plat embraces all that parcel of Land known as Lot number one the same being the east tract or parcel of land in a certain tract of land surveyed and platted and recorded on page 297 in book A of Deeds in the office of the Register of Deeds of Ford County, Kansas the said tract lying, being and situate in Lots 3 and 4 of Section 26 and in the South 1/2 of the south west 1/4 of Section 26 Township 26 and Range 25 west of the 6th Principal Meridian being in Ford County and State of Kansas. Said Lot Number One is the same Plat commencing at a point 50 fifty feet North from the center of the A.T. & S.F. R.R. Tract and running north along the west line of Dodge City 1000 chs thence west 480 chs thence south to within 50 ft of the center of the A.T. & S.F. R.R. Tract thence east along the south line of said track to place of beginning.
